

Dear Clean Environment Commission

I was at the Portage La Prairie Clean Environment Commission Hearing in Portage the other day and I did not hear any mention about the NH₃ Anhydrous Ammonia Fertilizer Tank on the Trans Canada Highway at Agrium Bloom Distribution Fertilizer Terminal on the Trans Canada Highway your Bipole III Hydro Transmission Hydro Towers and Lines are supposed to go 1 mile and 1/2 West of the NH₃ Anhydrous Ammonia Fertilizer Tank on the Trans Canada Highway just West of Portage La Prairie and the Aerial Applicators will not spray our crops and our neighbors crops in fear of them clipping the Bipole III Hydro Transmission Hydro Towers and Lines and spinning out of control and hitting the NH₃ Anhydrous Ammonia Fertilizer Tank on the Trans Canada Highway. Also when the Clean Environment Commission was talking about the Tornado at Elie Manitoba that Tornado was right above our farm before it hit Elie Manitoba so coming with the Bipole III Hydro Transmission Hydro Towers and Lines in our area is not a good thing and this why we were hoping that the Clean Environment Commission can reroute the Bipole III Hydro Transmission Hydro Towers and Lines so that they are not so close to the NH₃ Anhydrous Ammonia Fertilizer Tank it would be a lot safer for every one if the Bipole III Hydro Transmission Towers and Lines can be rerouted. Agrium Bloom Distribution Fertilizer Terminal is also on the Environment Act and also on the Terrorist Watch List two main reasons why the Bipole III Hydro Transmission Hydro Towers and Lines need to be rerouted or put under ground. Please let me know as soon as possible on what the Clean Environment Commission decides.
