Comment: These comments relate to the CEC review on the hog industry. I

am an elected representative of the LUD of Swan Lake. We submitted a petition of 155 names to the RM of Lorne concerning a submission of a Technical Review Report for an application to put in a 4400 swine grower to finisher facility by Rock "N" Rolling Farm Ltd. The RM of Lorne told us that we were too late and that they'd file it. In this application it was proposed to put a 12,000,000 litre lagoon on the aquifer that supplies the water for our town. The odour was not properly addressed in this tech review, as was the handling of any mortality of the hogs. A number of farmers, in the area proposed for the barn, also wrote a petition against this barn. Again the RM of Lorne refused it. The Chief of the Swan Lake First Nation addressed the meeting and he was told by the RM that there was no reason for the RM to consider the First Nation's concerns. Since then I have met with Mr Stan Struthers with the Chief of the Swan Lake First Nation and the Chief of the Southern Bands. He assured us that there would be an impartal review. I hope this is the case. I am not against pork producers, I eat and enjoy pork. But please protect our water, and stop the huge growth of Large Confined Animal Operations on delicate aquifers, such as our water source. The Doctor in our community has also submitted

letters to the provincial ministers outlining his concerns for the

health of our area. So far only two have seen fit to answer him. In closing, if required I can produce the original petitions for your scrutiny, and I hope if nothing else you stop the fouling of our water source. Respectfully Stan F Saxton
