I find it very interesting on the Pembina Water Coop meeting at the Friedensfeld Community center

Mr Sam Schellenberg sitting in the center at one table in the S E, corner of the building like he could be on the tap control.

I especially enjoy his talk about the water hydraulics and recovery.

I can tell him we experienced that our well was pumped dry when we had a very wet fall the well was up to the top. That never happened to us before we had that 120 hog farm on 36-2-10 which indicates to me that we are on the same vein.

Half way between Letellier and Attona water tower the Knutt Bros had a well with very good drinking water

That well became unfit to use after they had an earthquake in Alaska (early 60's) from so far away.

So how much water do you need to flush the hog manure into the lagoons. Perhaps you have overbuilt hog barns, maybe that is your problem that your water supply can't fill, so you are coming to us to help you out.

Why waste water when you can use dry manure systems which are less polluting.
