Hi there,

Our family are neighbours to the Brokenhead Ojibway Nation, and as there is no town centre in our area, our mailing address is in Beausejour. We spend a lot of time in the Beausejour area, as well as in the area of our home, next door to BON.

We have been following the Vivian Project Silica Mining project and are concerned that we don't know enough about this process to ensure that groundwater will not be negatively affected.

As settlers who enjoy the vast wildlife and waterways of the Brokenhead First Nation, we would like to echo their request to have the project suspended so that it can be reviewed by a joint Federal/Provincial panel for Canwhite's adverse impacts.

Brokenhead First Nation has also requested that the Crown immediately undertake the Section 35 Consultation with them, as they believe that their Treaty Rights may be impacted by this project. They would like the Section 35 Consultation process to occur with the Crown before the Environment Act Approval process begins. Clean drinking water is, and should always be our priority over industry. Water is life. We hope this project will not be allowed to go ahead. Thanks for your consideration; updates appreciated.
